- CDPHE has approved an additional 56 homes for ventilation system performance inspections, bringing the total number of homes receiving inspections to 174. These homes have consistently demonstrated indoor levels of 1,1-DCE and TCE below current action levels and no longer require annual indoor air testing.
- The venting systems inspections will be conducted in the same quarter as the former air testing and take approximately 10 to 15 minutes to conduct.
- To date, CDPHE has determined that 148 homes no longer require indoor-air ventilation systems.
- As of November 1, approximately 63.3 million gallons of groundwater have been treated by the groundwater containment system at the former Redfield site. The system, which began operating in March 2000, operates continuously to prevent solvents in groundwater from flowing away from the Redfield site and beneath the surrounding area. The system also captures and cleans groundwater a short distance beyond the fence line. The existing plume is being diluted and flushed by the clean water reinjected by this system.
