

Brown Group Retail Retests Areas on Redfield Site

Brown Group Retail, Inc. is conducting additional scientific tests on the Redfield site in an area where some former employees of the rifle scope manufacturing facility have alleged on-site waste disposal. New soil samples have been taken to confirm previous testing that did not show this area to be a source of chlorinated solvent disposal.

The new testing will analyze 36 soil samples from 12 borings, followed by the installation of a groundwater monitoring well if necessary. To date, the company has installed 84 wells at the site and 70 borings for sampling. This includes 50 groundwater monitoring wells and 34 containment system wells on the site. The new testing brings the number of soil tests, including both soil vapor and soil tests from borings, to 368.

This new testing is being conducted under the oversight of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). The entire process, including the analysis of the results, will be shared with CDPHE and the neighborhoods.
